ABOUT THE HON. FLOYD GREEN

Floyd O'Brian Green is the youngest Minister of Agriculture. With deep roots in St. Elizabeth, he is now serving his second term as Member of Parliament. In September 2020, he secured the first second term victory for a JLP Member of Parliament in a contested election for St. Elizabeth South Western since 1967.

He read for a degree in History and a minor in Political Science at UWI, Mona and then was awarded his Bachelor of Law degree with Honours [LLB (Hons)] in 2006 from UWI, Cave Hill beginning his career as an attorney-at-law. Floyd is a founding member of the Mona Campus Youth League, which was the first chapter established for Generation 2000 (G2K), the young professional affiliate of the Jamaica Labour Party.

From 2016, he served as the Minister of State in the Ministry of Education, Youth & Information and then was assigned Minister of State in the Ministry of Industry, Commerce, Agriculture and Fisheries in 2019. Following his exceptional performance in the Ministry, Minister Green was appointed and is now serving the people of Jamaica as the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries.
